RIVER DEVERON VOLUNTARY CODE FOR MIGRATORY FISH JANUARY 2009

The recommendations below are a guide as to what your board considers an acceptable bare minimum to be observed by all fishermen.

Many beats will have their own, much stricter rules

- eg fly only, return of all spring fish etc and these are to be encouraged in the interests of all who enjoy fishing our river.

DAILY BAG LIMIT

*1 Salmon before 31st May with a maximum of 3 per week

Thereafter:

DAILY BAG LIMIT

2 Salmon

DAILY BAG LIMIT

2 Sea Trout per week

Return all Sea Trout 3lbs or more.

Return all Sea Trout under 10 inches.

DAILY BAG LIMIT

4 Brown Trout per week

Anglers should be encouraged to fish with fly only during low water conditions.

When spinning only one set of barbless or pinched hooks should be used.

No worming after 31st August except during a spate.

After 21st August Hen Salmon and Hen Grisle should be returned.

All gravid fish must be returned and all escaped farm fish must be retained.
